Who I am

What data I collect

If you contact me, I'll collect the information you choose to share – usually your name, email address, and the details of your enquiry.

How I use your data

I use your details only to:

- Reply to your enquiry
- Provide the services you've requested
- Keep necessary records for my accounts and tax obligations

Lawful basis for processing

I process your personal data on the basis of:

- Pre-contract: to take steps at your request before working together
- Legitimate interest: to run my business and respond to enquiries
- Legal obligation: to keep certain records for tax purposes

How I store your data

Your data is stored securely in my email account and, if we work together, in my accounting records. I use reputable, password-protected services and two-factor authentication where available.

How long I keep your data

- Enquiries: up to 1 year after our last contact
- Client records: up to 6 years to meet legal requirements

Who I share your data with

I don't share your personal data with anyone unless required by law.

Your rights

You can ask me to:

- Give you a copy of your personal data
- Correct any errors
- Delete your data (unless I need to keep it for legal reasons)
